Major fund-raisers operated by the Rotary Club of Sebastopol include the Cajun Festival, the Great Getaway, and the Crab Feed. The Cajun Festival is in conjunction with the Sebastopol Sunrise Rotary Club and is held the Saturday of Labor Day weekend. The Great Get Away is our major fund raiser and is held the first Saturday in November. The Crab Feed is held in February and supports the Teacher mini-grant program.
