The members of the club consistently donate personal time and money toward educational, world and community projects and wish to share the opportunity to join us in supporting these projects. To that end, this report reveals the scope of work completed by the Rotary Club of Sebastopol during the 2005-2006 fiscal year.

Funds donated for specific projects are a qualified charitable donation for income tax purposes. The Club is a "501C4" corporation that maintains a separate project fund for charitable expenditures.

Major fund-raisers operated by the Rotary Club of Sebastopol include the Great Getaway and the Crab Feed. The Great Get Away is our major fund raiser and is held the first Saturday in November. The Crab Feed is held in February and supports the Teacher mini-grant program. Other smaller "fun" raisers include the September golf tournament and the yearly poker tournament to benefit the Sebastopol Rotary Education Foundation.
